Applications, Examination & Testing

Applications:

- 1. Applications will be accepted year around at the Knox County Sheriff's Department
 - a. Hand delivered or by US Mail/Fed Ex/UPS only.
 - b. Faxed or emailed applications will NOT be accepted.
- 2. Within 90 days of submission, the Merit Commission will notify the applicant in writing if their application has been accepted by the Commission.
- 3. Applicants will be notified of the testing date and location.

Examinations & Testing:

- 1. Orientation
 - a. The Mandatory Orientation Meeting has been removed from the examination requirements by the Merit Commission.
 - b. In lieu of the meeting, an Orientation Letter from the Merit Commission has been added to the application.
 - c. The Merit Commission will conduct a short orientation with the applicants on test day before testing begins.
- 2. Written Examination The minimum written test score has been changed to 66%
- 3. Physical Agility/Power Test Patrol Applicants
 - a. Doctor's Release will be submitted on day of testing.
 - b. Physical Agility/Power Test is no longer pass/fail.
 - c. All applicants, except full-time certified officers, MUST *participate* in the Physical Agility/Power test.
 - d. Performance on the test will be taken into consideration when determining the applicant's final overall score.
 - e. All applicants, except for full-time certified officers, will be required to successfully pass the Power Test as part of any conditional offers of employment prior to being hired by the Sheriff's Department.
- 4. Doctor's Release for Physical Agility Testing (Form E)
 - a. Valid for 45 days after being signed.
 - b. Not submitted with application.
 - c. Turned in on day of testing.
