Criminal Justice Specialist Mark Lendman inspected the Knox County Jail on June 18, 2013. The entrance and exit interviews were conducted with Lieutenant Craig Carpenter.

IMPROVEMENTS SINCE LAST INSPECTION

- 1. The department now uses an IMPG computer-based training program for facility staff.
- 2. Visitation hours have been extended.
- 3. An additional telephone has been installed in the booking area for use by detainees in obtaining bond money.
- 4. There is now a report box for each holding cell to hold all paperwork pertaining to the arrestee assigned to that cell.
- 5. Two new vans have been acquired for detainee transports.

1. Facility configuration: A Block - 4 Single Detention Rooms (Maximum Security)

B Block - 3 Single and 4 Double Detention Rooms (Female)

C Block - 6 Single Detention Rooms (4 Administrative Seg, 2 Medical)

D Block - 20 Single and 3 Double Detention Rooms (Male)

E Block - 19 Single and 4 Double Detention Rooms (Male)

F Block - 19 Single and 4 Double Detention Rooms (Male)

G Block - 22 Single and 2 Double Detention Rooms (Male)

Booking - 4 Single Detention Rooms

- 2. On the date of inspection, female detainees were being housed in A Block also due to the female population count.
- 3. A medical unit consists of two single-bunked detention rooms with observation windows viewable from the main booking area.
- 4. The control room is equipped with four monitors and a keyboard system. All doors are opened and all cameras are monitored from this post.
- 5. On the day of inspection, 25 of the 100 detainees were being housed for the federal government.
- 6. The facility is equipped with a fire alarm system supplemented with a sprinkler system.
- 7. Both indoor and outdoor recreation is available.
- 8. Emergency power is supplied to the facility by means of a diesel generator which conducts an automatic internal self-test twice times weekly.
- 9. Non-contact video visiting is conducted on Thursdays. and Sundays. There are ten visiting stations.
- 10. Detainee phone service is provided by Securus.
- 11. Detainees diagnosed with mental heath disorders are referred to Bridgeway Mental Health Services. Bridgeway also provides detainees with needed prescriptions and necessary referrals.
- 12. Meals are provided by an on-site county cook. Trustees are utilized in the kitchen area.
- 13. All detainees are tested for TB during their 14 day medical screening. All security staff are tested as well.
- 14. Religious services are provided weekly by local clergy. Special visits by personal clergy are reviewed by the jail administration..
- 15. The facility's library doubles as a church area. Reading materials are donated to the jail. There is also a law library computer and attorney telephone available there.
- 16. The facility is equipped with an automated external defibrillator, two tasers, and Scott Air Packs, suicide mattresses and smocks.
- 17. Medical services are provided contractually by Advanced Correctional Health Care.
- 18. The facility is not equipped with a negative flow TB room.
- 19. Vermin and pest control services are provided by American Pest Control Service. The facility was last treated 6/18/13
- 20. Commissary services are provided by Swanson Commissary Service.
- 21. The laundry facility consists of two industrial strength washers and dryers as well as one residential washer for mophead Trustees are utilized for the laundering of clothing.

- 22. The facility does not securely detain juveniles. Juveniles in need of secure custody are transported to the Mary Davis Juvenile Detention Center in Galesburg.
